The Coalition

Only four members of the Coalition in the Senate chose to exercise a conscience vote to allow the territories the right to make their own laws on euthanasia.

The ALP

Seven members of the Labor Party voted not to allow the Territories the right to make their own laws on euthanasia. Eighteen voted for the Territories to make their own laws on euthanasia despite three of those being opposed to euthanasia.

One Nation

One voted one for and one against.

Independent

Five were for the Territories the right to make their own laws on euthanasia. Two were against.

Some senators neither spoke nor voted.

Six senators did not vote despite two of them speaking in the debate.
